NOTES

- Contrary to our previous NOTES on 8/24, it does NOT matter if the Zoom Host is In-Class or Remote. Today I hosted one Zoom session in N255; later we closed that session and Nelson was host at his home. Both sessions worked equally well.
- Our main problems occurred with acoustic feedback, usually caused by cell phones.
- We obtained our best results with the following setup:
 - N255 audio system ON
 - Handheld mic ON
 - Cart Projector ON
 - Cart audio amp and speakers ON
 - Cell phones on Zoom with Mic Muted and audio output minimized
- We tested projecting a "lesson", and that could be seen and heard by all.
- We played a YouTube video, and that could be seen and heard by all.
- In-class participants could see and hear remote participants.
- Remote participants (Nelson) could see and hear events in N255 (Active).
- Remote participants (Nelson) could be seen and heard in N255 (Passive).

QUESTIONS

- Is it possible to completely disable audio output from a cell phone? If so, how?

PROBLEMS

- acoustic feedback, even participant IN ROOM with Zoom mic muted
- IF (and this is a BIG if) we want a wider-view camera, we will need Roland's password to disable ThinkPad camera and enable USB wide-view camera. Personally I think we need to leave the Cart setup exactly "as is" we don't want to cause problems for other Cart users.
