



The Bible

Was written by our religious ancestors in biblical Israel.



- The Bible is a human product.
- The Bible tells us how our religious ancestors saw things, not how God sees things.

The Bible Tells Us:



- Our religious ancestors' stories about God and their experiences of God
- Their convictions about what God is like and what the will of God is
- Their wisdom about the way we should live
- Their praise and prayer

The Bible Tells Us



- About our religious ancestors' grief and despair
- About their puzzlement and questioning
- Their ethical teaching

Rachel says that the Old Testament tells us:




- Words that articulate the human experience

fairy tales are more than true; not because they tell us that dragons exist, but because they tell us that dragons can be beaten.


