The Question.....





This program offers certified teachers from Early Childhood to High School science and math. Along with teaching, our teachers create individualized curriculum for each student.

- The program is the only open-ended one that focuses on the needs of children and their families.



- Mission: To Break the cycle of violence for women and their children through long-term transformational care that seeks to restore faith, hope, and health.
- Provides long-term housing that is critical for helping domestic violence survivors permanently escape abuse.
- It is the "bridge" from a shelter, which typically allows women a safe place for 30 to 90 days, to independent living, free of the barriers preventing them from achieving self-sufficiency away from their abusers.






Plain-O Helpers

- The organization also provides items such as school supplies, mosquito nets and clothing.






