... and would defend without question


YET

1) The Almost Death of Moses

Background:

- Moses met God at Burning Bush



- Moses had Received his instructions about Pharaoh
- Ex 4: 13
- Then the Lord's anger burned against Moses ... Ex 4:14
- Moses finally agreed and prepared to go to Egypt
- Ex 4: 24

"Now it came about at the lodging place on the way that the LORD met him ...

....and was about to Kill Him."


Wait

At Mt. Sinai:

- Moses has gone up the mountain for a long visit
- The people in camp make a Golden calf
- God not too happy Ex 32: 10

¹⁰ "Now leave me alone so that my anger may burn against them and that I may destroy them."

Moses calms God down
 Ex 32: 11-13

- Do you really want to do that?
- You know what the Egyptians will say
- Remember your deal with Abraham?

²² "Do not be angry, my lord," Aaron answered. "You know how prone these people are to evil.


²³ They said to me, 'Make us gods who will go before us. As for this fellow Moses who brought us up out of Egypt, we don't know what has happened to him.'

Who was this guy ... Cyrus?



- Founder of the Persian Empire
- Conquerer
- Aggressor

He believed in 1 God . Who made Heaven and Earth ... the Creator of ALL

Cyrus' decree

Ezr 1: 2-4

2 "This is what Cyrus king of Persia says:

"The Lord, the God of heaven, has given me all the kingdoms of the earth and he has appointed me to build a temple for him at Jerusalem in Judah.

3 Any of his people among you may go up to Jerusalem in Judah and build the temple of the Lord, the God of Israel, the God who is in Jerusalem, and may their God be with them.




4 And in any locality where survivors may now be living, the people are to provide them with silver and gold, with goods and livestock, and with freewill offerings for the temple of God in Jerusalem."

Feast of Dedication


- Back in 2nd Century B.C.
- Antiochus Epiphanes (Greek King) captured Jerusalem
- Temple defiled, 40,000 Jews slain
- Pig sacrificed in Temple



Feast of Dedication

- Judas Maccabaeus leads revolt... and succeeds for a period
- Daniel proclaims that it will take 2300 days until Temple is purified
- 2300 Days later it was celebrated as a "Day of Cleansing" or
- Feast of Dedication


Celebration day fell on December 25








Destruction of Jerusalem







Angel tells Joseph to bolt to Egypt... WHY?


...because Herod IS GOING to kill the child

Who else was at risk here?



Mary and Joseph went to Jerusalem every year for Passover This time it was special... Jesus was 12... becomes a man




Boy Jesus in Temple
