


After Cana

- Some Interesting Notes:

- The Synoptic Gospels have Jesus' ministry lasting one year
- John's account is for 3 years
- This is the first of at Least 4 trips to Jerusalem per John
- The Synoptic Gospels only record the Triumphal entry (Other than the Childhood appearances)
- John places the Temple Cleansing during the emergence

Some notes on Passover in Jerusalem:

- Every adult male Israelite was required to go each year
- Each family had to shell out money TWICE:


Temple Tax

Buy your sacrifice

- You could bring your own sacrifice but ...
- Buying your animal from Priests was a guarantee
- Your cash was no good Had to be Temple Coins


All Cash Transactions were "Owned" by Temple Priests

- This used to happen outside the City.....



Jesus got upset because:

- They moved the Money changing INSIDE the temple walls
 - To the court of the Gentiles
 - The Gentiles can not worship... can not trespass



Preaching in Nazareth

Background:

- Jesus' reputation was growing
- He was invited to speak in Nazareth



- Three parts of Synagogue Service....
 - 1) The Worship Part
 - 2) The Reading of the Scriptures
 - 3) The Teaching Part
 - Jesus was invited to do Parts 2 & 3 that day

Preaching in Nazareth

The Reading:

- He read from Isaiah
- They were amazed at his words


The Teaching:

- Then ... Luke 4: 24 27
- Elijah not sent to Israel's aid ... but to Sidon
- Elisha not sent to Israel's aid ... but to a Syrian
- Jesus was paying a compliment to *Gentiles*
- Jews believed that God created Gentiles ...
 ...to be fuel for the fires of Hell




²⁸ All the people in the synagogue were furious when they heard this.



Background:


- Jesus had been healing many

Customs in Palestine back then


... When a Father died

 - Slides box into slot in wall



Jewish Beliefs

- The Messiah would be the most destructive conqueror in history

John in Prison


