



Jewish Mourning Rituals

Due to climate, burial was as soon as possible

After body leaves house

- All furniture 'reversed '
- Mourners sit on ground

Belief was that the soul hovered over the body for 3 days

After 3 days Really, really dead

- 1st 3 days Very Heavy mourning
- Next 3 days Heavy mourning
- Next 24 days mourning

The Apostles Raise people from the Dead


Acts 9:36-42 Tabitha Is Raised from the Dead

³⁶ A woman who was a follower lived in the city of Joppa. Her name was Tabitha, or Dorcas. She did many good things and many acts of kindness. ³⁷ One day she became sick and died.

After they had washed her body, they laid her in a room on the second floor. ³⁸ The city of Lydda was near Joppa. The followers heard that Peter was at Lydda and sent two men to ask him to come at once. ³⁹ Peter went back with them. When he came, they took him to the room. All the women whose husbands had died were standing around crying. They were showing the clothes Dorcas had made while she was with them.

Acts 9:36-42

⁴⁰ Peter made them all leave the room. Then he got down on his knees and prayed. He turned to her body and said, "Tabitha, get up!" She opened her eyes and looked at Peter and sat up. ⁴¹ He took her by the hand and lifted her up. Then he called in the faithful followers and the women whose husbands had died. He gave her to them, a living person

Paul - Eutychus


Acts 20:7-12 Eutychus Raised From the Dead by Paul


⁷ On the first day of the week we came together to break bread. Paul spoke to the people and, because he intended to leave the next day, kept on talking until midnight.

⁹ Seated in a window was a young man named Eutychus, who was sinking into a deep sleep as Paul talked on and on. When he was sound asleep, he fell to the ground from the third story and was picked up dead.





¹⁰ Paul went down, threw himself on the young man and put his arms around him.

¹¹Then he went upstairs again and broke bread and ate. After talking until daylight, he left.


The Guards had many challenges in Jeruslem...

"No one ever spoke the way this man does," the guards replied.


Thursday at the Garden

How many Guards does it take to arrest a Messiah ?

How Many Guards ?

Judas then, having received the Roman Cohort and officers from the chief priests and the Pharisees, came there with lanterns and torches and weapons. John 18:3 New American Standard Bible (NASB)

- A 'Cohort' was normally a force of 600 men
- Some scholars suggest it was only a 'Maniple"
- A 'Maniple' was normally a force of 200 men
- Including officers from the Chief Priests & Pharisees...
 - Possibly a group of 225 Total came to arrest Jesus

Friday at the Cross

Guards whipped Jesus

Guards pushed Jesus

Guards Nailed Jesus

Sunday at the Tomb




The Triumphal Entry Crowd


Given where the crowd formed

They came because of the rumors of miracles






The Good Friday Crowd

Pentecost

When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place.² Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. ³ They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. ⁴ All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues^[a] as the Spirit enabled them. Acts 2:1-4



The believers (a group numbering about 123) took to the streets and spoke in tongues



¹³ Some, however, made fun of them and said, "They have had too much wine."
¹⁴ Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice and addressed the crowd:
