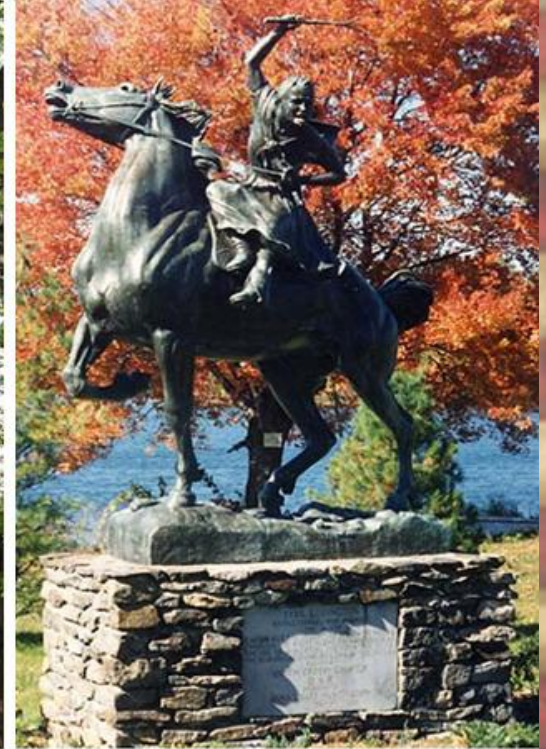


# Comparison Of The Two Rides



Paul Revere's Ride

1. The purpose of both rides was to warn the citizens of a raid by British Regulars and a call to arms .
2. Date: April 18, 1775
3. Distance: About 10 miles.
4. Weather Conditions: Clear Night
5. Road Conditions: Easy well-traveled roads.
6. Captured and never completed ride to Concord.
7. Age: About forty years old.



Sybil Ludington's Ride

- April 26, 1777
- About 40 miles.
- Thunderstorms
- Unmarked woods, muddied trails, farmers' fields, few roads.
- Completed her ride
- Sixteen years old

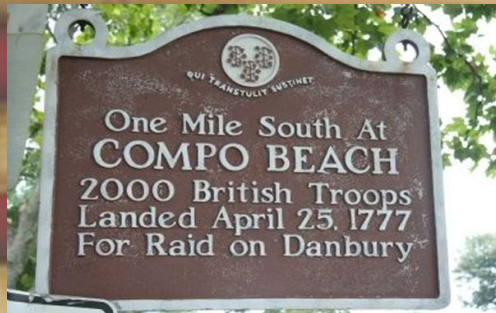
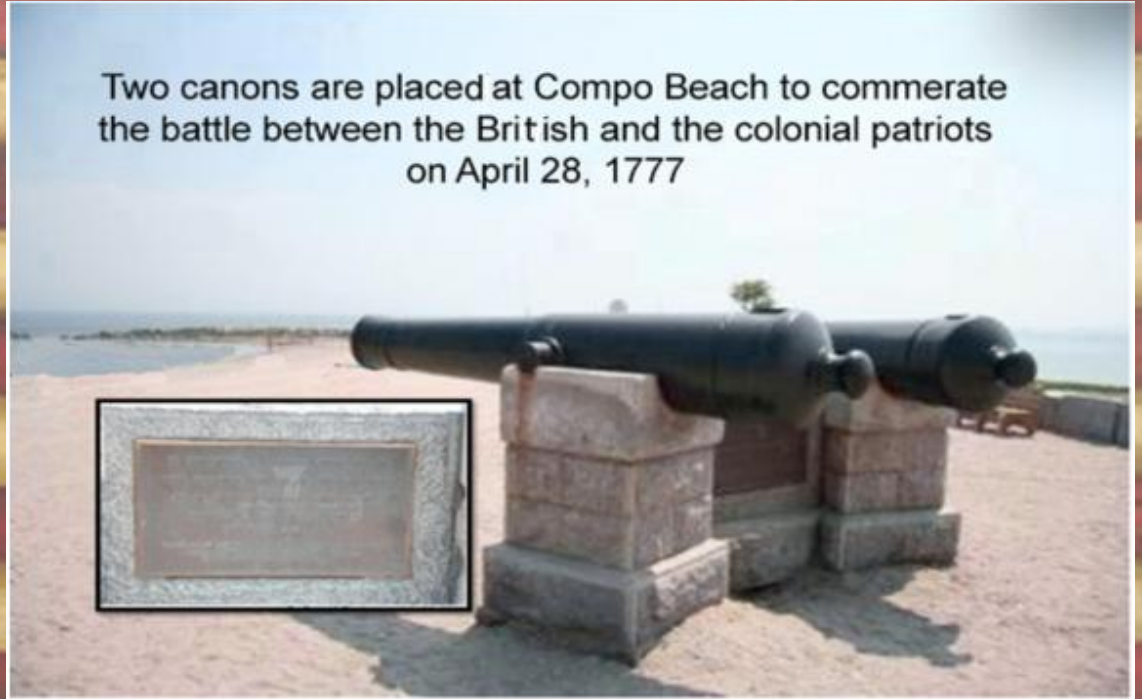








Two canons are placed at Compo Beach to commemorate the battle between the British and the colonial patriots on April 28, 1777
