# Assisted Living Ministry



Christ United volunteers visit with church members and neighbors who reside at assisted living facilities in our community.

Volunteers provide spiritual support, fellowship, Communion and prayer.

There are several opportunities to serve others including sing-alongs, bible studies, assisting with devotional or worship teams, and serving on the ALM committee.

# Congregational Care Ministry

- Trained lay chaplains are on call as needed and provide hospital and rehabilitation visits to church members.
- Lay chaplains also provide in-home visits to homebound members offering fellowship and Communion.
- Christ United volunteers provide on-going care to senior church members by making care calls for wellness check-ins.



# Divorce Support



- Divorce support group offers a divorce recovery program with intentional steps toward healing and wholeness during and following a divorce.
- This program is held in the Spring and Fall.

# Grief Support

Christ United offers a grief support group by providing a safe and caring space for sharing grief and loss.

We offer two grief support venues—an on-going monthly meeting held the third Monday of each month, and a grief support class held bi-annually in the Spring and Fall.





# Meal Delivery

Christ United volunteers offer meals to those who have recently been hospitalized, have a new baby, who have had a death in the family, or are temporarily homebound.



# Memorial Services

- Christ United Care Ministry offers compassionate planning for memorial services in the sanctuary or chapel, as well as inurnment services at Christ United's columbarium.
